

The University of Arkansas – Fort Smith, established in 1998, formerly a two-year institution, merged with the University of Arkansas System as a four-year public, co-educational, four-year university in 2002. It is one of 11 campuses that make up the University of Arkansas System and is located in Fort Smith, Arkansas. UA Fort Smith is the sixth largest university in Arkansas, with an enrollment of approximately 7,300. In 2003 the campus was named the "Best Maintained Landscape in the Nation".
