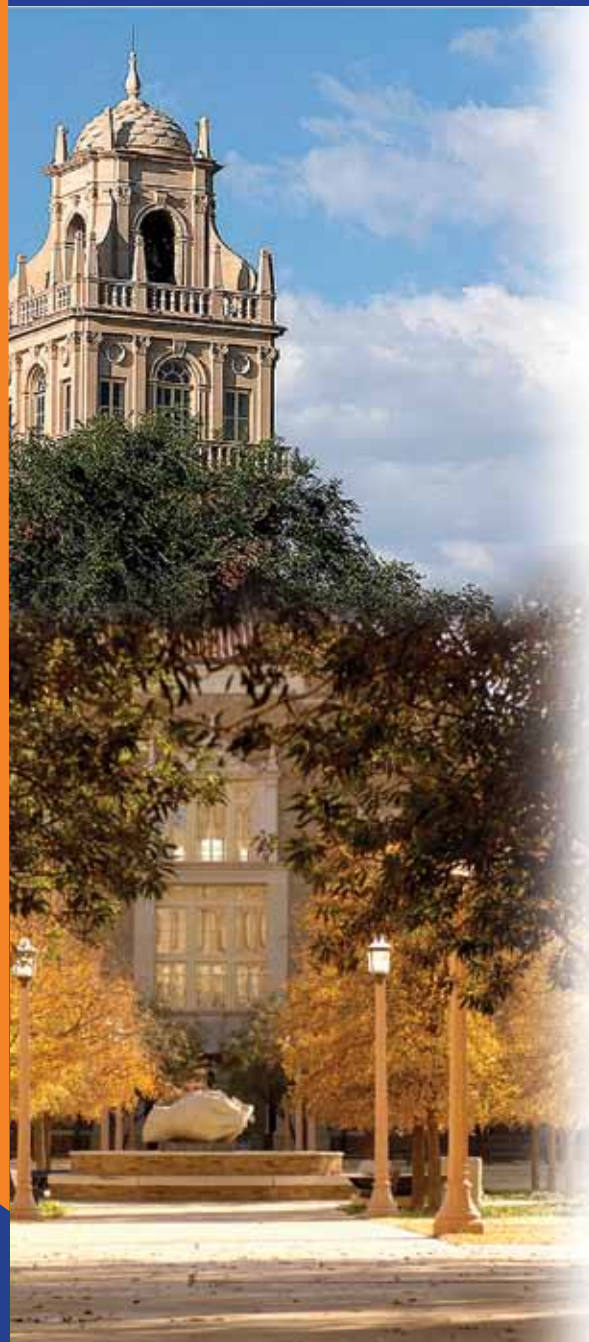
Texas Tech – Top University at an Affordable Price
